NHS

- 26bn NHS funding for more resources, nurses and doctors
- Public drugs manufacturer
- Free NHS prescriptions



Care

- Free personal care for older people
- Winter Fuel Allowance, free TV licences and bus passes for pensioners
- Free childcare for 2-4 year olds
- More youth clubs and services



Green Industrial Revolution

- £250bn Green Transformation Fund for insulating homes, offshore wind, Northern Crossrail
- 27m energy efficient homes
- A million climate jobs
- Ban fracking

Work

- Real Living Wage £10 p/hr
- 32-hour working week
- Workers on boards
- Stronger Trade Union law



Education

- Scrap tuition fees
- Free further education
- Free school meals
- End Sats exams
- Abolish Ofsted
- End tax breaks for private schools



Internationalism

- Foreign policy values of peace, universal rights and international law
- End detention centres
- End the hostile environment for migrants



Investment

- £150bn Social Transformation Fund for schools, hospitals, council homes
- £250bn National Investment Bank for infrastructure, research and innovation



Social security

- Scrap Universal Credit, 2 child limit and benefit cap
- Comprehensive social security system
- Reinstate legal aid



Housing

- 100,000 new homes a year
- Rent control and secure tenancies
- 8,000 homes for the homeless



Brexit

- 1. Negotiate a credible leave deal
- 2. Call an immediate referendum
- 3. Offer remain and credible leave deal

How we'll pay for it

- Fully costed manifesto - paid through taxation, productivity or redirected revenue
- No tax increase for anyone earning less than £80,000 a year (95% of taxpayers)
- Take on tax dodging
- Bring corporation tax back to 2011 levels.
- Tax multinationals and hedge fund managers

This won't harm business! UK corporation tax is the lowest of any developed economy.
